Medha Learning Foundation (hereinafter referred to as "**Medha**"), Lucknow, registered as a not-for-profit Company under Section 8 of the Companies Act, 2013 (erstwhile Section 25), which expression shall include, unless excluded by or repugnant to the context, mean the Executive Director, Medha Learning Foundation, and include his successor in office, legal representative, nominee and assignee as the "**Second Party**". The registration number of the **Medha** is U80904UP2011NPL045664 dated 11.07.2011. Its DARPAN ID is UP/2017/0170126 dated 18.12.2017. Its registered office is at 407, Dr. Baijnath Road, New Hyderabad, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh- 226007.

WHEREAS

Medha is responsible for enhancing the employability skills and improve employment outcomes of students at Mihir Bhoj P.G. College, Dadri, Greater Noida, Gautam Buddha Nagar

1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1.1 DEFINITIONS

- (a) "**College**" means Mihir Bhoj P.G. College, Dadri, Greater Noida, Gautam Buddha Nagar
- (b) "**Programme**" means the employability and entrepreneurial development works/activities like counselling and mentoring sessions, workshopsetc., to be performed by the second party pursuant to this MoU.

1.2 RELATION BETWEEN THE PARTIES

Nothing contained herein shall be construed as establishing the relation of purchaser and seller as between the first and second party. The second party, subject to this MOU, shall be fully responsible for the task completed by them.

1.3 GOVERNING LAW & JURISDICTION

This MOU, its meaning and interpretation, and the relation between the parties shall be governed by the laws applicable in India and they only shall have exclusive jurisdiction over matters relating to or arising from this MOU.

1.4 LANGUAGE

This MOU has been executed in English language, which shall be the binding and controlling language for all matters relating to the meaning of interpretation of this MOU.

1.5 LOCATION

The matter i.e., Programme implementation arising under this MOU shall be performed by the second party at College only.

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1.6 AUTHORISED REPRESENTATIVES

Any action required or permitted to be taken, and any document required or permitted to be executed under this MOU may be taken or executed:

- (a) On behalf of the first party, by the Principal, Mihir Bhoj P.G. College, Dadri, Greater Noida, Gautam Buddha Nagar , or their designated representative.
- (b) On behalf of the second party, by the Executive Director, Medha Learning Foundation, or his designated representative.

2. COMMENCEMENT, COMPLETION, MODIFICATION AND TERMINATION OF THIS MOU

- 2.1 This MOU shall come into force from the date of signing, or other earlier date that is mutually agreed by the two parties.
- 2.2 Modification of the terms and conditions of this MOU, including any change in the programme as agreed, may only be made by prior written agreement between the parties.
- 2.3 The College introduced this programme to enhance employability and entrepreneurial skills and improve the employment and career learning outcomes of its students and alumni.
- 2.4 Medha will be implementing this programme for a period of two years from the date of signing this MoU, which might be extended, and the MoU may be renewed for another similar period, based on mutual agreement.
- 2.5 Medha also reserves the right to terminate the MoU under the any of the following conditions:
 - Grant Funds not available from the donor for implementation
 - Lack of coordination and support from the college
 - Force Majeure conditions

The involvement of Medha and the role of college will be as per following:

3. ROLE & OBLIGATION OF THE SECOND PARTY IN SUPPORT OF PROGRAMME

- 3.1 The Programme will be delivered exclusively to the students and/or alumni of the College, , who shall be required to abide by all the rules and regulations of Medha, as communicated at the start of the course
- 3.2 Registration to the Programme is entirely free for all the interested students of the College. No fixed fee/charges of any nature shall be levied at any stage of the Programme. However, after successful completion of the module, the students who wish may "voluntarily" contribute to Medha Learning Foundation by online (mode) through the web-portal of Medha.
- 3.3 The Programme shall run r for the students enrolled in various U.G./ P.G. programmes in the college as part of such skilling in the following manner:
 - 3.3.1 Implementing Employability Skills and Life Skills programme.
 - 3.3.2 Entrepreneurship Skills.
 - 3.3.3 Activating a thriving alumni network.

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3.3.4 Improving industry exposure through expert talks, mentoring, industry visits, workshops, and other initiatives.

3.4 While executing educational tours, exposure visits and expert workshops, facilitated by Medha, students may be asked to bear partial costs related to their own expenses based on the mutual understanding between Medha and the Student.

3.5 Medha shall abide by all the terms and conditions mutually agreed upon with the college in the implementation of the different programme, counselling, and mentoring, etc.

3.6 The Programme will be delivered by personnel appointed by Medha. Medha shall provide other support to the college from its head office/regional office, as and when required.

3.7 Medha shall abide by all the rules and regulations of the college in its functioning at the college.

3.8 Medha shall furnish all relevant information, progress reports and impact evaluation reports corresponding to the project, to the college as and when required or demanded by the latter.

3.9 Medha will be providing offline & online classes and practical training, including industry Visits, research, and demo projects as prescribed under the programme, to the students registered within the given time slot. Medha shall also be responsible for maintaining the attendance records of these students.

4. ROLE & OBLIGATION OF THE FIRST PARTY IN SUPPORT OF PROGRAMME

4.1 The College shall provide access to a suitable room / venue for conducting the training and Programme activities with access to electricity, wireless internet, student furniture and other basic amenities/facilities, as available at the College.

4.2 The College shall allow Medha to communicate with the students both virtually or on campus about the Programmes and activities. These activities and courses may be conducted in offline mode within the College premises, and may also be conducted online with the prior permission of the principal, if necessary.

4.3 The College shall allow Medha to communicate the students about the Programme implemented by means of signboards, notices, e-posters & banners, link on its official website, awareness events and workshops etc. organized from time to time either virtually or on the campus in consultation with the College.

4.4 The Department of History, MBPGC, shall be the nodal department to coordinate with Medha for the implementation of the programme at the College under this MoU. The Nodal Personnel from the department shall also ensure that half-yearly review meetings are held with the principal to assess and monitor the progress of the programme.

4.5 The number of activities to be implemented in an academic year shall be decided with the consent of the college.

4.6 Under this MoU, any department/ cell / committee or club of the college can organize various activities conducted by Medha.

4.7 The College shall allow cobranded (College in collaboration with Medha) printed certificates to be issued to the students successfully completing the modules

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4.8 The College shall ensure full support and cooperation to the Medha staff in all aspects of the program functioning to ensure effective delivery of the program.

4.9 Each batch will ideally have 25-35 students. The batch will be formed only if there will be minimum 25 students in a batch.

4.10 The infrastructure established by Medha may be utilized by the College for academic purposes, provided that such usage does not interfere with the delivery of the activities under this MoU

5. DIGITAL PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION ACT

Both parties will ensure that as per the Digital Personal Data Protection Act 2023, any data or information related to the staff or students which is shared as a part of this agreement would be kept confidential and will not be shared with any external party.

6. REPORTING OBLIGATION

The **Second Party** shall submit to the **First Party**, reports and documents as may be specified and at such frequency as may be agreed upon between the two parties. The **Second Party** will collect and maintain the records of students and shall monitor & evaluate and report to the **First Party**.

7. ARBITRATION

Both the parties shall use all reasonable endeavors to resolve or settle the disputes through mutual negotiation and discussions in connection with this MOU or the interpretation thereof. Any and all disputes, controversies and conflicts ("**Disputes**") arising out of this Agreement between the parties or arising out of or relating to or in connection with this Agreement or the performance or non-performance of the rights and obligations set forth herein or the breach, termination, invalidity or interpretation thereof which cannot be settled or resolve amicably shall be referred for arbitration to a suitable committee at the College. The arbitral award shall be in writing and shall be final and binding on each party. None of the parties shall be entitled to commence or maintain any action in a court of law upon any dispute arising out of or relating to or in connection with this MOU.

8. CONSEQUENCE OF BREACH


- a. It shall be obligatory on part of either party to ensure delivery of the program as per the pre-approved plan as agreed in the MoU.
- b. In the event of breach of any term or conditions of this agreement, either party shall have the right to terminate this agreement with prior notice of one month, or the matter shall be subject to the arbitration clause as above if both parties agree on the same.


